Child abuse is hard to talk about. These words are on the the cover of the brochure for Liberty House. Our guest speaker today did talk about child abuse.

Allison Kelley is the CEO of Liberty House here in Salem. The nonprofit provides individual and family services in a neutral child-friendly environment. The following information is from their web site, <u>LibertyHouseCenter.org</u>:

Liberty House is a child abuse assessment center serving Marion and Polk counties. Liberty House offers a safe, comfortable, child-friendly environment for children and their families facing concerns of abuse, neglect, trauma, or grief. Our experienced staff members know how to help children and teens, and can provide support so children and their family members can get the help they need with fewer appointments and more coordination.

Liberty House opened in 1999 starting with a block grant. Ms. Kelley has been with Liberty House since 2005 and became CEO in 2013. She is an attorney, graduating from Willamette & Willamette Law school. She spearheaded the effort to expand services, increase staff and double the number of clients seen.

She is the proud great-granddaughter of past Oregon governor Oswald West, who established Oregon's beach highway law, proclaiming the entire Pacific coastline to the high tide line to be a public highway, thereby preserving scenery and beach access for future generations.



Oswald West (May 20, 1873 – August 22, 1960) was an American politician, a Democrat, who served most notably as the 14th Governor of Oregon. He was

called "Os West" by Oregon writer Stewart Holbrook, who described him as "by all odds the most brilliant governor Oregon ever had." (text from Wikipedia)
