Nancy's talk was on three main subjects: The search for the new School Superintendent, **Christy Perry**; The **Common Core State Standards** Program in Oregon; and the new **Mountain West Career Technical Institute** in Salem. She quoted some interesting statistics regarding the Salem-Keizer school system such as

- S-K is the second largest school district in the state.
- 59% of the students qualify for free or reduced lunches.
- Last year graduates earned over \$14 million in scholarships.
- 470 high school students graduated with a 4.0 GPA.
- 3,981 students are enrolled in career or tech education courses.
