Our Program Speaker today was **Tricia Ratliff**. She is the Executive Director of HOME Resource center in Salem. HOME is a part of the Community Action Agency.

Community Action provides services to people in need and HOME specifically helps teens with a variety of resources. Ms Ratliff outlined the various aspects of how her agency helps youth with things like job hunting, mental health issues, meals, and shelter. They provide computers, sports activities as well as the basics of clothing, laundry and help with family and friends. The services are designed for youth from age 11 through 17, or 18 if still attending school. The Center is housed in a vintage house in downtown Salem and will celebrate a Grand Re-Opening of their expanded services and newly improved facility on September 24.

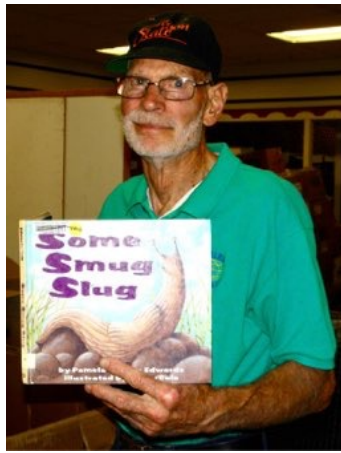

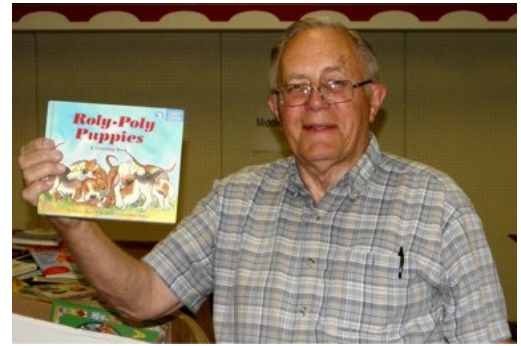

BIG BOOK SORT OF SMALL BOOKS

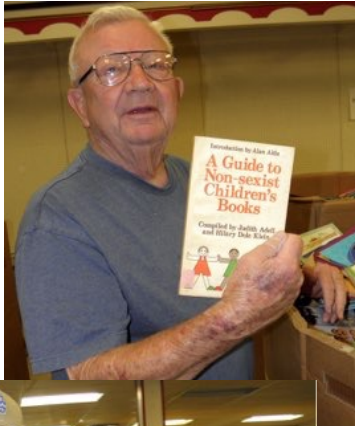

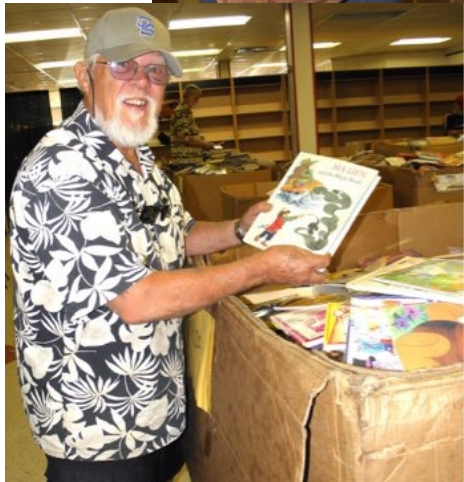

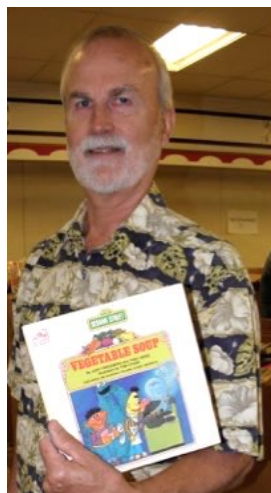
