KOD **Marc Iwahiro** was our **Kiwanian Of the Day**



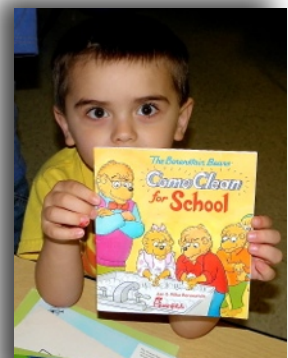
today. Marc is a past president of the club and has been a member since
