It is best known for its role in the War of 1812. It was the valiant defense of the fort by 1,000 Americans that inspired Francis Scott Key, a lawyer and amateur poet, to compose “The Star Spangled Banner,” originally entitled “Defense of Fort McHenry.”

Frank talked about the U.S. Flag and the proper ways to display the flag and its symbolism.
