Greg Barrick announced that next week we will cast votes on a Kiwanian of the Year for our club.

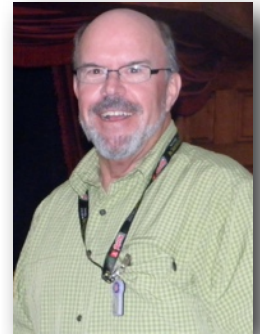
President **Don Hallauer** had announced that we were going to have a general discussion on how we can work on improving the club but we did not have time today.
