Phil is originally from Tualatin which began as a small village called Galbreath at a ferry crossing on the Tualatin River. Samuel Galbreath began ferry service in 1853. In 1856, Galbreath built the first bridge across the Tualatin River, and the town's name was changed to "Bridgeport."

In 1886, the Portland & Willamette Railway Company purchased a right-of-way through John Sweek's land on the Tualatin River's west bank opposite Bridgeport. Profiting from the sale, Sweek took

advantage of the railroad's location and platted a town around the depot he called the new town Tualatin. The city is



celebrating their centennial this year.
