**M**eals on **W**heels Program Manager **Mel Fuller** was our guest speaker today. She has been in that position for about a year. Meals on Wheels volunteers deliver more than a meal: they deliver social connection to seniors and disabled adults. Most volunteers deliver one day a week for about 2 hours and have about 10 deliveries. The cost of the meals is \$4.50. The food is prepared fresh daily Monday thru Friday. Two frozen meals are delivered with the fresh meal on Friday.

When Mel started with Meals on Wheels they were delivering 150 meals per day, now they deliver some 350 meals per day in Salem and Keizer. In July they took over the South Salem Senior Center kitchen and dining room and serve about 50 seniors a day.
