## GUEST SPEAKER

**Elise Bauman** was our guest speaker today. She told us about the operations of *Salem Harvest* which is the largest food harvesting organization in Oregon. Since 2010, volunteers have worked to provide thousands of pounds of good fruits and vegetables to Marion-Polk food Share as well as other agencies helping to feed families in our community.

Ms. Bauman passed out a brochure on Salem Harvest and a card showed how a donation of \$25 can provide 625 servings of veggies and fruits or 167 pounds of fresh food for over 100 local food pantries and emergency food banks throughout Salem, West Salem and areas in rural Oregon including churches and community centers.
