SALEM FREE CLINIC

Our guest speaker today was **John McConville**, Director of the Salem Free Clinic. He started with the clinic as a volunteer some three years ago. He became Executive Director January 2015.



The clinic started in 2005 with one doctor, one nurse, and one volunteer.

In 2008 the clinic moved into the Broadway Commons building. They now have volunteers from over 70 churches. They provide free medical, dental, mental health and counseling services. Salem Free Clinic is a safety net for people who do not have medical insurance. They have some 5500 patients visits per year. The Affordable Care Act has made a big difference. The clinic went from being overwhelmed to now being able to help most folks with same day services.


