## GUEST SPEAKERS

Salem Police officer Matt with his K9 partner, Jake, who did speak on command, came to the meeting today to talk about how police dogs work with their handlers to find and subdue criminals. Many Dogs like Jake come from trainers in the Czech Republic and will cost \$10,000. The dogs start training at 8 weeks old. Commands are in the native language. When Officer Matt gives commands to Jake they may include the following:





English:	Czech	(Pronunciation)
Sit	Sedni	(sid-nee)
Down	Lehni	(lay-nee)
Stand	Stuj	(stuuya)
Stay	Zustan	(zoo-stan)
Heel	Knoze	(no-say)
Come	Kemne	(come-enye)
Speak	Stekej	(esteke)

Dogs are used in police work because their sense of smell may be as much as 100 times better than a human's. The human nose has only three-square centimeters of olfactory membrane where some dog breeds, such as the German Shepard, have as much as 150 square centimeters of scent-sensing material in their noses. Dogs also have forty times more scent processing cells in their brains
