Rick Gaupo was our guest speaker today. Rick and his wife Elizabeth have lived in Salem since 1986. They have two children. One of his passions is long off-trail backpacking trips to places like the Olympic National Park & the Grand Canyon.

Rick is the President and CEO of Marion-Polk Food Share. Before joining MPFS, he was the CEO of Habitat for Humanity of the Mid-Willamette Valley.

The Marion-Polk Food share is a place where 16,000 children a month get healthy fresh food. It is also serving many many families in the local community. In addition to providing food, the non-profit is also operating a 240 acre farm and is in the process of growing wheat and other agricultural products.

In a new project, they are working with the Oregon Youth Authority training youth in the areas of commercial food prep. A veggie burger has been developed that is turning into a major commercial food project. After experimenting with textured vegetable protein, TVP, the Food Share is growing Quinoa on their farm for the burger which eliminates the use of soy and gluten which has become an issue with many people in the community.



KOD John Fox was our Kiwanian of the Day. John is a native of Salem and he grew up in Portland.

John has been a member of the Salem Kiwanis Club for almost 20 years. He and his wife Tracy have a “blended family” with 5 children, ages 24, 23, 21, 17 & 15, with the youngest still living at home.

John has worked with the Oregon Youth Authority for the past 11 years. He works in the finance area of the agency. For his fining session John asked questions on “This day in History”.
