GUEST SPEAKER

Our guest speaker today was Salem Fire Chief **Mike Niblock**. Chief Niblock has been with the department for over 30 years. He became Chief in 2009.

The Salem Fire Department was founded in 1857, two years before Oregon became a state.

Currently the city maintains nine fire stations, down from eleven a few years ago. They do a lot more than fight fires; most calls to the fire department involve health and safety issues. Medical emergencies are the most frequent, including heart attacks, auto accidents and rescues from many situations including drownings and hazmat incidents.

Personnel number 150 down from 175 due to budget cuts.

Chief Niblock talked about the new Salem Fire Foundation, started in 2014, which has a goal to achieve the highest “save rate” for sudden cardiac arrest in the country.

This non-profit 501(c)(3) is dedicated to community outreach and CPR/AED training, fire prevention and risk awareness, assistance for firefighters and their families and employee development and recognition.

The SFF will train some 4,000 8th graders in CPR and AED every year. AED is the Automated External Defibrillator device that can improve the chances of survival from SCA two-to-three fold.

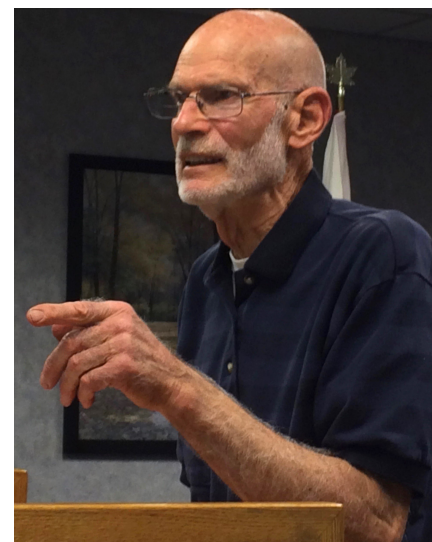
