YOUTH PROTECTION GUIDELINES (effective October 2016)

All adults working with youth under the age of 18 at any Kiwanis event are expected to read/understand, agree to, and abide by these guidelines.

Education: Every Kiwanis club is expected to educate its members on the Kiwanis Youth Protection Guidelines. Each year, a club should provide members with a copy of the Guidelines with educational training—informing them of the highest standards of conduct and awareness.



Our meeting today was a review of Kiwanis guidelines with regard to working with youth presented by Marcia Kelley.

The guidelines set requirements for all Kiwanis members working directly with young people in any capacity to have a criminal history background check completed and current.

A background check will be valid for a period of two years.

Attending a Kiwanis event that requires an overnight stay, requires no fewer than one adult male for each 10 or part of 10 youth males and one adult female for each 10 youth females or part of 10 youth females, with an exception for a parent sharing a sleeping quarters with his/her own child.
