Alison Kelley was our guest speaker today. She is the CEO of Liberty House. Ms Kelley was formally Marion County Community Services Director. She joined Liberty House in September of this year.



Since 1999, Liberty House has provided child-focused, high quality assessment services to children when adults are concerned that they may have been hurt by sexual or physical abuse or neglect. The statistics are alarming. Over 1200 instances of child abuse and endangerment are reported every year in Marion and Polk counties. Liberty House has the ability to provide their services to only about 400 to 450 of these cases.

Liberty House serves children from birth to age 18. Their services are voluntary and free of cost to the family involved. All services are carefully coordinated with local law enforcement and child welfare agencies in order to provide the highest levels of support for children and their families.

Ms. Kelley outlined several areas where help is needed. Both financial and volunteer help is greatly appreciated.
