Melisa Lindley is the Community Outreach Coordinator with Willamette Valley Hospice here in Salem.



Hospice Care is a type of care and philosophy of care that focuses on the palliation of a chronically ill, terminally ill or seriously ill patient's pain and symptoms, and attending to their emotional and spiritual needs. About 50% of patients spend 17 days or less in hospice and 20-30% are at hospice for 7 days or less. Over 25% of Willamette Valley Hospice patients are veterans.

Willamette Valley Hospice offers Music Therapy as a treatment modality for hospice patients and bereaved clients. Willamette Valley Hospice remains the only hospice in the state of Oregon with two full-time music therapists on staff to serve patients with a variety of concerns.

Willamette Valley Hospice offers the Edward F. Tokarski Home for patients who need a place to call home in their final months of life. This adult foster home offers 5 private bedroom suites.
