Kylie is a Salem native and a graduate of Willamette University.

Her presentation today was on the newest exhibit at the Heritage Center in 10 years, the 1909 caboose that in the past rolled on the tracks right by the center's building. At one time the caboose was used for some student housing at U of O in Eugene.

With a group of hard working volunteers, the unit was brought to Salem and sits on the property of the Heritage Center. The exterior

of the caboose needed lots of work to keep out the elements. This portion of the restoration has been completed with many hours of volunteer help.

The next efforts will be on the interior which still has some of the original furnishings such as the sink, the "ice box" and other furnishings that made the unit a living quarters for train crews.

A platform will be constructed to allow access since the floor of the caboose is high off the ground.

The plan is to create an exhibit of educational displays to show some of the history of railroads in the greater Willamette Valley.
