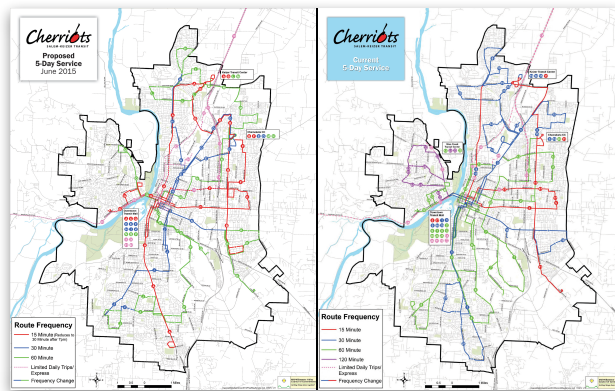

**O**ur program today was presented by two gentlemen from the Salem-Keizer Transit District. General Manager **Allan Pollock** and **Matt Berggren** who is one of the newer members of the "Moving Forward" project.

After a study by the firm of Jarrett Walker Associates, the agency conducted a series of community outreach events to address the issues of the new plans. The Moving Forward project will be accomplished in 3 phases. Phase 1 will be completed in September 2015. Phase 2 and 3 have not been funded yet so there is no time line for completion.

Phase 2 will expand service to evenings and phase 3 will cover weekends and holidays. The maps below show the current routes in the right hand map and the proposed new routes in phase 1 in the left hand side.
