Guest speaker Steven Maxwell

The EyeCare • WeCare mobile Eye Clinic serving the Philippines.

Steven Maxwell is a member of the Ross Island Early Risers Kiwanis Club in Portland Oregon. He is the District Director of the S.O.S. - Save Old Spectacles program in Division 70. This program has been collecting used glasses for some 20 years. Mr. Maxwell has been involved in the program for about 9 years. He works with the EyeCare WeCare Foundation that was founded by Dr. Weyrich. His efforts help the poor people of the Philippines with their vision issues.

Maxwell outlined the kind of glasses needed including readers, Rx glasses, including children's glasses, sunglasses, and even just the frames alone as long as they are not broken. He also provides free collection boxes that can be distributed in the community to collect glasses.

Our club donated some 100 pair of glasses for this worthwhile program.
