GUEST SPEAKER

Shelby Maerz was our guest speaker. She is with the Salem-Keizer Indian Education Department. Title VI Indian Education program serves over 700 Pre-K through 12th grade students representing 92 tribes in the United States.

The Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) is central to the program. Parents of Indian Eduction students, high school students enrolled in the program and teachers identify needs of Native students, give recommendations regarding programming, approve the grant application and assist in fund raising for events such as the Eagle Feather Graduation Celebration. Through this long standing program students learn to apply math principles to cultural arts such as painted drums and deer toe wind chimes. Writing workshops include scholarship resources and applications. Study hall is available once a week for one-on-one help with teachers and tutors.

Parent Education Workshops help parents build skills and knowledge of available resources for them in the community.
