


KOD

Today's KOD was Jim Fahlstrom. Jim talked about his career with the Oregon Pulp & Paper Company here in Salem. The plant where he worked was built in 1920 and was operating until June 1982.

The Salem paper mill was a sister plant to a mill in Vancouver WA that was owned by the publisher of the Oregonian, London born Henry Pittock and his wife, Georgiana.

Boise Cascade purchased Oregon Pulp & Paper in 1962 and a yeast plant was added to convert byproducts of paper making into a food additive called Torula yeast. In 1964 a container plant was added to supply cartons for food processing plants. Several improvements were made under Boise both to expand production and to meet air and water quality standards; purification lagoons were built on Minto-Brown Island across the slough.

Jim was there until 1983 when the property was sold.



THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS

John Moody presented the program today on Christmas hymns including The 12 Days of Christmas. Although no one is quite sure exactly how old the lyrics to "The Twelve Days of Christmas are, they were already considered "traditional" by the time the rhyme

was first published around 1780. The theory that it originated as an "underground catechism song" for oppressed Catholics appears to be quite modern, however. It was first proposed by Canadian English teacher and part-time hymnologist Hugh D. McKellar in an article entitled "How to Decode the Twelve Days of Christmas," published in 1979. McKellar expanded on the idea in a monograph for the scholarly journal *The Hymn* in 1994. The notion was further popularized by a Catholic priest, Fr. Hal Stockert, who summarized the theory in an article he wrote in 1982 and posted on line in 1995.
