- **Be clear and succinct.**
- **We look for:**
 - **Important needs of young people in the Greater Manchester area met effectively – the number supported and the quality of support;**
 - **The impact of the Kiwanis grant on the program (generally not for overhead); and,**
 - **Opportunities for Kiwanis to promote Kiwanis membership growth and volunteer occasions.**
- **While total money available is \$30,000 and there are no other restrictions on size, historically the Club has made grants of less than \$3,000 each.**
