Tips:

- Be clear and succinct. Your funding request MUST address food insecurity for children 18 and under within the Manchester area.
- We look for:
 - How the program is executed, the number of children supported, and the quality of support.
 - The impact of the Kiwanis grant on the program.
 - Opportunities for Kiwanis to promote Kiwanis membership growth and volunteer occasions.
- Applicants must not have received funding from Kiwanis for the same program within the past 12 months; organizations may apply for funding for a DIFFERENT program within their organization. If this is the case, be sure to explain how this request is different from the request that was funded within the past year.
