# SIGN UP FOR THE JOHN DEERE CLASSIC!

## Hole #2 & Hole #3

<u>Online registration will begin on April 16<sup>th</sup>.</u> You should be getting an email from the John Deere Classic letting you know the volunteer signup on the John Deere Classic website is live.

If you volunteered last year, you'll be getting an email from the JDC asking you to volunteer again.

Regarding the signup online, I know it can be frustrating but I'm hoping you will persevere. Let me know if it gets too much and I'll see what I can do. Our security code is **KiwanisClub** (all one word and caps matter). Also remember to click the drop down box to indicate you are working with our group the **Quad City Area Kiwanis Clubs.** 

If you are in the Bettendorf (Doug Nelson), Camanche (Don Lambert), Clinton (Cathy McDanel), Davenport (Pete Schlicksup), Geneseo (Chris Gillet), Moline (myself), Muscatine (Michael Gaeta), or Rock Island (Don Wentler) clubs we have a coordinator who you should sign up through. If you don't have a connection with one of those clubs or coordinators, let me know and I'll get you signed up. Remember you need to sign up **both online with the JDC and through one of our club coordinators.** If your club doesn't have a coordinator, just let me know. You'll need to sign up for a specific day or days. If the day or hole you want to work is filled up, sign up for another day. But tell your club coordinator which day you really want to work. That is what I will work off of. After everyone signs up and I review who we have for what days, I may ask some of you who have flexibility to adjust the day you volunteer. I would prefer you work full days if possible but if you really want to work and can only do a half day, I'm sure we can work it out. As was the case last year, our days will start around 6AM Wednesday thru Sunday, and end around 6PM Wednesday thru Friday and around 2PM on Saturday and Sunday.

Volunteer shirts will cost \$27 and if you need a hat (and you have to have an official JDC hat) it will cost you either \$15 or \$20, depending on the style you get. You can have your uniforms delivered to you (for a fee) or pick them up on either 6/17 or 6/18 from 10AM to 6PM at the Isle Casino

Hotel Event Center. All volunteers get a free round of golf (though you have to pay a \$40 cart fee) after the tournament, free lunch on the days you volunteer, and are eligible for daily prize drawings. Plus you can attend the post event concerts on both Saturday and Sunday.

Remember, we are no longer "Marshals", we are "Gallery Managers". Should you have any questions, please let me know. Thanks for your help in the past and I'm looking forward to working with you again this year.

**NAMI Walk** - Members gather one Saturday a year, typically in the fall, to walk this 5K together in support of the National Alliance on Mental Illness.

<u>Special Olympics</u> - Kiwanians support local youth Special Olympics athletes by awarding medals at the annual Scott County Special Olympics, typically held in the spring, to support the achievements of these remarkable youth.

<u>Administrative Assistant's Day Roses</u>—In order to raise funds to provide grants to the community, members sell roses by the dozen to members of the community. We also accept donations and deliver roses to senior citizens living at Good Samaritan Society Senior Living in Davenport.

## Go to davenportkiwanis.org for fillable application and online submission.

Grant submission deadline is each quarter on the following dates: January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st. Decisions are finalized by the next grant cycle. Applicants can apply once per year.

Grants will be based on the following criteria scored with the following point scale:

Project directly benefits area children, 0-18	4 points	
Project directly benefits youth, 19-21	2 points	
Project benefits the community	3 points	
Kiwanis member (s) is/are involved	2 points	
Project is located within Davenport	2 points	
Project has matching Kiwanis grant if outside		
Davenport city limits	2 points or NA	
Applicant has presented at Kiwanis meeting		
Since last award	2 point	
Applicant provided photos of supported event	2 point	
Applicant posted to social media crediting Kiwanis		
With support for project	1 point	
TOTAL POINTS AVAILABLE	20 Points	

## NOTE:

\*All applicants are expected to present at the noon Kiwanis meeting within the year of application.

\*All applicants upon grant approval shall provide electronic photos of the program which Kiwanis supported.

\*All applicants shall note the support of Kiwanis on their social media outlets.

\*Applicants may only be awarded one per fiscal year.

\*Applicants will forfeit application submission for one year if program photos are not provided or mention on social media is not done.

\*No applicant should assume ongoing annual funding.
