Don earned his PhD at Cornell University and was an Emeritus Professor in Philosophy at BGSU, where he helped develop the Environmental Ethics program. As an environmental ethicist, Donald's passion was to protect and sustain natural entities and resources. He published many articles and several books. He was on the Board and past President of Green Energy Ohio and was involved in Habitat for Humanity in addition to Kiwanis, which he joined on November 4, 2021. He was an Elder of First Christian Church in Bowling Green. Born in Detroit, Donald was a fan of the Tigers, Lions, Redwings, and Pistons. Don loved music and played cello and piano. He cherished spending time with his family and was devoted to his family and community. We will miss him dearly.

Don is survived by his wife Char (a long-time Kiwanian), his children Karen (Mike) Krueger of Bowling Green and Mark (Nadja) of Passau, Germany, his sister Carole (Jim) Enwright of Warren, Michigan, and eleven grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
