






In Memoriam

David Cook Young



The Reverend David Cook Young, former president of Bowling Green Kiwanis and retired Presbyterian Minister of Word and Sacrament, died July 17, 2025, on his 60th wedding anniversary, with his beloved wife Marcia and family by his side.

David served Fairgreen Presbyterian Church of Toledo, OH, and First Presbyterian Church of Bowling Green, OH, before retiring to Indianapolis in 2017.

David was born in New Rochelle, NY, on February 16, 1936. A 1958 Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Bowdoin College in Maine, he earned his Master of Divinity from Union Theological Seminary in NYC in 1962 and was ordained in Hudson River Presbytery. David served the Presbyterian Church (USA) in Ohio and New York. For 14 years he was pastor of First Presbyterian Church of Bowling Green. Upon retirement, he served congregations in Northwest Ohio as a transitional pastor. David was president of Kiwanis Club and chair of the Human Relations Committee of Bowling Green.

David ran long distances, competitively and for enjoyment, for six decades. He was a voracious reader, and filled yellow legal pads with his scholarly, contemporary, and humorous sermons. He imbued the ministry with critical analysis, dignity, music, and warmth.

David is survived by his wife, Marcia Young of Indianapolis; daughters, Jennifer Young (Anthony) Dzwonar of Indianapolis and Jessica (Kurt) Young Brust of Union Mills, IN; four grandchildren; and a brother and two sisters. He was preceded in death by his parents Richard and Virginia Cook Young.
