Amazing grace, how sweet the sound
 That saved a wretch like me
 I once was lost, but now I'm found
 Was blind, but now I see

'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear
 And grace my fears relieved
 How precious did that grace appear
 The hour I first believed

- Newton wrote the lyrics for "Amazing Grace" to accompany a sermon he gave on New Year's Day in 1773.
- The song was first performed at Lord Dartmouth's Great Hall in London.
- It was published in 1779 in the book *Olney Hymns*, which Newton compiled with his friend William Cowper.
- The song is based on 1 Chronicles 17:16-17, a passage from the Bible where King David responds to the prophet Nathan's announcement of God's promise.
