We undertake fundraising activities such as the annual Community Lottery (sold out again for 2025); Community Breakfast & Bake Sale (February 16, 2025), Chicken Barbecue (August 14, 2025); our annual bonspiel (January 11, 2025); the sale of Nevada tickets; Pavilion rentals and events (e.g. Rock n’ Roll Dance Party with the Reasons on May 23, 2025).
