Steve Collins introduced our speaker – a familiar face – Carla Strong, executive director of Howard Training Center. She has been in that job for 5 ½ years, inheriting a non-profit that was, in her words, "in deep yogurt."

The center has a new name, Howard Prep, and the rebranding is intended to move away from the perception that the center is only about preparing meals for the senior meals on wheels program. The center was losing money on that program and had to step away.

Under Carla's leadership the center has consolidated its facilities – saving \$\$\$ on rent -- and continues to prepare their clients (people with various disabilities) for the workplace and living on their own. She shared upbeat stories of clients who are working at local businesses.

"Our clients will surprise you each and every day by what they can do," she said.

The non-profit gets its funding from the state Department of Developmental Services, employment contracts with government agencies and private businesses and donations. Our club donated \$2,000 in March.
