Last Friday morning, Marty Villa interviewed Jeff Pishney, exec director of Love Modesto, and that Zoom recording was shared during our Zoom meeting this morning.

Jeff said that while the annual event had to be postponed from April 25 until Oct. 3, much good has come out of the organization's evolution into a neighbor-helping-neighbor strategy working closely with the county's Office of Emergency Services and many other agencies and organizations. The theme is Get Help/Give Help. Among the ways that is happening:

- 250 people have signed up as neighborhood champions, volunteering to check on their neighbors
- 1,700 deliveries of food have been made to seniors and others at risk
- volunteers are providing staffing for food pantries that might otherwise have shut down
- hundreds of masks are being made

Jeff said he anticipates that the fall version of Love Modesto will look different, without a mass gathering to start the day. More likely, small teams will be sent directly to their volunteer assignments.
