Speaker-Ruben Imperial is the Director from Stanislaus County Behavioral Health. He moved to his position on March 17<sup>th</sup> which is funded by Medicare and Medical. The focus is on Prevention.

The work with severe mental health kids and adults and provide mental health with a stable environment. They go through rehab to get well and back to a normal life, by getting their peers and family helping. They see about 8K to 10K people in treatment a year.

COVID-19 they do tele health-helping to get them into a safe and stable housing. 25% to 27% are homeless in Stanislaus County due to not taking meds for mental health and 30% to 40% are due to substance abuse. He did mention that he has not seen any COVID-19 cases. Very low.
