(Later Thursday, the Stanislaus County Housing Authority announced it is buying the complex and will put its administrative offices there and renovate the property to include “150 units of housing for entry level workers, including those from nearby retail and other business settings. The facility will eventually host other small businesses in a campus like setting and accommodate future development of Retirement Workforce Housing on a lot located on the property.
