PROGRAM

Speaker Cindy Duenas , Director at Center for Human Services. The organization offers mental health and substance abuse services to youth.

They have seen 700 teenagers in the past three years.

The Youth Navigation Services that they offer try to catch young people before they get into a cycle of chronic homelessness.

Hutton House offers transitional housing with 8 beds in 3 rooms in a home style setting.

Pathways transitional housing has 15 beds in a dorm setting. They have seen 63 people in the 16 to 21 age group and 3 related young children. But another 180 have not been able to be seen due to lack of resources.

Low barrier shelter has 24 beds also in a dorm setting. Allows pets and has minimal rules so that as many as possible can be admitted.

Also, telecare and drop in services for this community.

The top reasons for youth to find themselves in this situation is family conflict, mental health issues, substance abuse and financial issues.

Youth who have come through foster care are likely to end up with homeless episodes due to lack of support and resources.

Lately the Center has been running at 50% capacity due to Covid.
