116 campuses in California. Largest higher education system in the world. South Hall is the first building built for a community college in California. Nice picture of the college looming over a beautiful lakescape. (flooding ♥)

1923 the first track meet and the 1st place trophy was won by MJC and presented by Rotary Club of Modesto.

George's mother came from Greece in 1952 taking the train across Canada and getting married 4 days after meeting her Modesto husband in Vanouver; for immigration purposes! But the marriage worked and they stayed together. First thing she did was enroll in an English class at MJC!

MJC students have experienced so many historic events over the last 100 years. The latest being Covid which required upheavals in teaching methods. Also, the students 3D printed 3000 face masks.

Incoming students have 78 percent needing basic skills in Math, 50 percent basic English skills. Of current students 50 percent have a housing insecurity. 59 Percent have some form of food insecurity.

Pirates micro grants are 300 dollar grants based on faculty recommendations. Examples are Julia with food insecurity. Johnathan with overdue bills. Christina who lost her apartment and is the best student in math.

Enrollment problems going from 19000 in 2019 to 14000 in 2021. 62 % female 38% male. Average age 24 or so.

MJC stories. Wallace Morrow, former controller of Stan County bought in a check for his mother Ada who both were at MJC together.

Anna Marie was in drug trouble but turned herself around and graduated.



Juan Ortega came from an LA gang background and graduated.

Bob Stewart , 47 years perfect attendance, athletic hall of fame.

Actor Jeremy Rennes, MJC grad.

Sam Porter, starts his first English class, gets a D, drops out. For 6 years. Then gets his degree, masters, doctorate and is now writing instructor at UC Merced.

Class of 2018, Andrew got a nursing degree after taking one class a year over 10 years. Is now working as a nurse in Modesto.

At \$46 a unit MJC has the lowest tuition in the USA. But the real money problem is not tuition but cost of living.

About 40 students a year go on to UC Merced and 700 to CSU Stanislaus. Would like, to see more go on to UC Merced.
