PROGRAM: Steve Collins introduced the "unknown speaker"

The unknown speaker was revealed to be Dr. Fritz Reid who was asked to speak by Pete Vella. Dr. Reid is a part of Ducks Unlimited, the second largest conservation organization in North America. Was incorporated in 1937 in Washington DC, it is now 85 years old. They host an annual Ducks Unlimited Dinner to raise funds for all their efforts to help protect ducks.

The Boreal Forest is the single largest biome in the country. Two-thirds of the forest is in Russia/Scandinavia and the other one-third is in North America, and is roughly 1.5 billion acres in size. It is also the wettest forest out there making it very unique. 50-70% is wet, containing lakes, marshes, streams, rivers, etc. It contains twice as much carbon as a tropical rainforest

Ducks come from two places, the Prairie Pothole Region or the Boreal Forest, making up 83% of the duck population. 3-5 billion birds fly out every fall, consisting of 200+ bird species. There are over 600 communities of indigenous people in the Boreal Forest.
