Business services. 100 million in construction. Big impact on community. Projects all over the district. Have been able to get a stadium venue for regional events which wasn't possible before. Food services provides almost 20 000 lunches. 3000 kids transported each day.

Technology. 29000+ student computers. Now all students are on chrome books. Tech support for students and families.

Curriculum and instruction

The year starts with 'New teacher boot camp' and professional development for all teachers need to return to a consistent curriculum after the difficulties of Covid period.

Student support.

3500 students with disabilities. Each with an IEP

2700 students in after school programms.

600 students in before school programs.

Priorities over the first weeks were support of students and staff.

Communications

Festivities on first day of school for TK 6. Also energy, excitement and fun at High school 9-12 during the first days of school.

Health and safety protocols. District adhering to latest COVID guidelines. Masks optional but recommended. Testing capabilities. Covid is here and is not going away.

School security is a serious issue. New systems being implemented. Response plans. Secure campuses with single entry points.

It is important to engage parents and be able to support parents. There are now a slate of online classes for parents and work is ongoing to get the parent to be a full partner.

Questions.

Do we have enough teachers? Only 11 positions open. In Modesto we have a stable district and ensure employees pay and benefits are competitive. Professional development is also helpful. MCS has a 'principal pipeline' to gain home grown principals. Still need bus drivers!

IB and Ap courses? IB and AP program has gone down during Covid but hopes to see it recover. Students may not have wanted to opt for tough classes during the tough two last years.

Bond measure? We need a lot of improvements and maintenance at school sites. Covid dollars cannot be used for this work.
