A'Kia Walker.

Exec director for Stanislaus Youth Empowerment Program. New startup in the 503c community. Build equity in our youth so they can be leaders in the community.

3 projects.

Tutoring program, student academic retention. Has been virtual but is about to go in person.

Community garden. 'Rooted and Rising'. Improve food access for local food deserts. Starting in West Modesto. Land stewardship and healing practices.

Black leadership project. Similar to the Hispanic leadership Initiative. Teach young people to become leaders.

Started in 2020. Very young organisation. Funded by a grant and tutoring is supported by MCS.

Young kids 3 to 11 have been involved in the community garden. Currently working on getting the parcel rototilled and planted with corn , beans and squash.

Judy Herrero explained that A, Ian has been selected to a Next Gen program funded by Dave Olsen of Taco Bell which gets young people on non profit boards. Akia is assigned to Stanislaus Equity Partners.
