Our program this week was Executive Director of UCP, Chris Martin, and her Trusty Sidekick, Ignacio Chavez. Chris is a member of the Kiwanis of Greater Turlock and the other club that starts with an "R".

UCP is an indispensable resource for those with Cerebral Palsy, and they also still serve a variety of other disabilities as well. They serve clients from Oakdale, Wesley, Newman, Patterson, Turlock, and Modesto among other cities. They have Day Programs in Modesto and Turlock where they teach life skills and employment skills. They have Employment Programs in different areas like landscaping, recycling, and janitorial services. Through their internship program, they have many members that are working with different businesses throughout the county. Two of which work at Burnside Body Shop with Brent. Their paid internship program provides the wages and job training to help individuals prepare for jobs.

They also have different social clubs such as Aktion Club and Buddy Club. Aktion Club is a branch of Kiwanis and is a service club for adults with disabilities which is sponsored by both North Modesto Kiwanis and Kiwanis of Greater Turlock. Buddy Club is an extension of Aktion Club which is a social program for young adults to get together and hang out. They also host Camp UCP every summer. They host about 35 campers for 1 week each at Camp Tuolumne
