Judy Herrero introduced Carla Strong from Howard Prep previously known as Howard Training Center which we have supported for many years. Name change to emphasize Prep for life in community. Accompanying Carla was Jesus who also works at the center.

There is a program 'Home at last' which matches disabled individuals with families. What happens when circumstances change. Matches individuals with families in community so that can give them a space. Match families carefully. Background check, home inspection. They have their own room, free access. Dynamite program to give disabled people a home.

Case worker and team available to help with the transition and ongoing.

More clients than homes.

Howard is currently a sub minimum wage workshop. But now have to start paying full minimum wage. This causes problems as it is harder to find jobs for clients and also they may earn enough to lose benefits.

Placements in local businesses along with a Job coach until they are trained. Appleby's, Save Mart, Safeway, Smart and Final have provided jobs..

Also remember the 27th year of their crab fest. Now a drive through rather than at a Location. Gumbo, chowder and crab. First weekend of February.
