Dean said that in 2008 he had hit rock bottom. Made a lot of poor choices. Decided to turn things around. Substance abuse. Could not go back to his old stomping grounds in south Modesto as he knew he would be dragged down.

Had a food stamp card and that's all. Went and sat and got the idea to do a ministry 'church in the park' and started it in 2009.

Went to the park and shared hot dogs and chips and had a prayer circle. Started playing volley ball with an old net and a soccer ball and got the homeless to open up to him.

Dean said that he figured if he found a need and filled it then it will open to the spiritual need.

Saw the need to provide cleansing services to the homeless. Saw they needed to be clean to ask people for jobs. Realized they needed facilities bought to them.

Started with the idea of a porta-potti shell on a trailer but was on the back burner.

Was offered a shuttle bus and saw that would work better. Roger Ricketts offer a shuttle bus and created a mobile shower bus. Went to SFO to se an outfit there that had a mobile shower bus.

Have a little fleet now of three vehicles, Grace, Faith, Mercy.

The program has just celebrated their 13th anniversary.

In 2020 they launched the laundry bus.

They came up with other services such as a phone charging station.

Clean bodies need clean clothes. Give them tools to restore dignity in themselves.

Dean spoke with energy and from th heart but he said he is nervous; Nervous to ask for support. Good at boots on the ground stuff. Bad at asking for help. The program has costs. Works out to \$10 a shower. Now it is more. They have no government funding.

Monthly budget 17000

Uses water hook up and drain.

Has travelled to fires to offer showers to evacuees.

Hoping to cover Turlock and Merced who need this service too.

The Laundry Bus was outside for members to have a tour.
