Us navy convalescent hospital

Which branch of service operated a hospital in Yosemite? The US Navy in Yosemite Nat Park.

The Awahnee Hotel was built in 1927

In 1940's the Navy needed a place for convalescing sailors. Wanted a place that was not just a grey building. The Navy leased the Ahwanhee Hotel and 37 acres.

Commissioned on June 25th 1943.

49 men arrived the next month.

Hotel bar made into a chapel.

Put in a guard shack and fenced off the 37 acres.

Eventually 800 or 900 men were housed.

Small hospital was set up.

Dining room was set up as mess hall.

Patients went on fishing trips, 9 hole golf course, bike riding, skiing in winter.

The Navy had its first Christmas in Yosemite in 1943.

Bought in orchestras for dances. Also girls from the valley would go up to the dances.

Rehab and recreation buildings in army field tents were set up. Dental office, barber shop and bowling alley. Movie night. Billiard. Library with many books donated by Kiwanis Clubs.

Decommissioned in 12/15/45.

Stephanie's older sister was born in November 45 and her older brother born in June 44. Two of very few people actually born in Yosemite.

6752 patients were treated in 2 1/2 years.

Stephanies father was a Lieutenant Commander helping administer the hospital.

In 2003 her father, aged 91, spoke at a Yosemite collectors club meeting.
