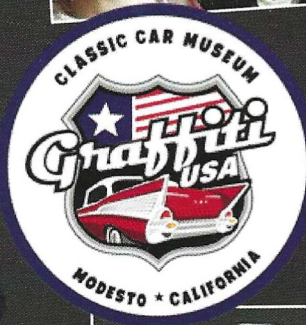

The little village located several miles east of Amsterdam featured lots of home-grown vegetables and tantalizing bakeries. Kristina cared for chickens, dogs, cats, and the owner’s garden. She said the chickens were a little too productive and she gave away eggs. Her primary transportation was an electric bicycle although she had access to a car. Gas, she said, was about \$9 a gallon. She went on some 40-mile bike adventures and explored Netherlands by train. The community was very friendly, and most people spoke English.
