Pediatrics suite now at the hospice house

- Camp Wokini - Friday- Saturday. Any child that has experienced a significant loss. The hospice works with a variety of community entities who refer children to this camp.
- Using a Pinecrest facility, this year 71 campers attended- over half lost a significant person quickly/ tragically. The camp guides them through the grief process with art therapy, professional therapists and plenty of adult support.
- The Hospice also works with local schools through their School Grief Program.
