Gary W - this is a big improvement from previous chili cook offs. When he participated last, he got a can of tennis balls...







## PROGRAM: Charlie and Brent - All Car Show

We are having a Car Show this weekend. The Parade kicks off Friday going through Downtown Modesto and up McHenry Ave. Judy says that we are definitely 1000 plus cars for the Parade.

Some tips from Charlie for the Parade: You are not encouraged to be law enforcement, there are plenty out there that will help address any concerns. Help car owners get off the route if needed for overheating or whatnot, and back on to the route if needed. Streets start closing at 3PM, use your judgement when allowing people



in and out of the area if they need to be. Be aware of the individuals on bikes, scooters, etc. If photographers/videographers go out on the street to stop cars for photos/videos, that is NOT okay. We only have two official photographers, Cory Warner and Dave Garcez. Any others should be asked to not stop flow of traffic, if not comfortable saying so, flag down an officer to ask them to address the individuals. No throwing out candy, we don't want to have children potentially getting hurt. Charlie does NOT want us on the front page of the newspaper for anything negative. Please try to prevent burnouts as much as possible.

Dignitaries will be out there and Chris Murphy will have his amplification system during the Parade as well. If you didn't know it, our Kiwanis Club was honored last night with a star on the Walk of Fame right in the 10th street plaza, check it out when you get a chance. We are the Grand Marshal this year and we will be having a few Key Clubbers sitting in a car to help us lead off the Parade. The Assistant Chief will be representing Modesto Fire and MacKenzie Phillips will be out there again this year. Charlie, Brian Sanders, and MJC wrestling team will be picking up trash along the route at the end of the Parade. There are 5 street captains with golf carts that will deploy vests for volunteers at different sections of the route. They will be the roving eyes and ears of the Parade. There is ONE Parade entrance at Orangeburg and McHenry coming in on the west side of Orangeburg. There will be a split downtown onto 10th and 11th streets for the turn around on that end. Parade entrants have info on their packets to always have the sticker on the car to signify that they are in the Parade and to keep their packets in the car to help alleviate any issues that may arise. If in the Parade, there will be a "Yes" on the sticker or a written in yes with initials. Parade entrants can start feeding in at 3PM and park on the curb until it is safe to stage on the roadway.

Brent is happy to see all of the people that are here today to help make this event a success. There are a lot of get together parties along the Parade route, especially on McHenry. They will



try to get into the Parade while it is happpening, please be careful. Ask an officer for help if needed.

Car Count: 1170 is total registered. We have 1000 for the Parade, plus whoever else Brent has said yes to. 16 cars are out of state, 74% are local. The car make most registered are Chevy's. No dogs, no bikes, and no unattended children. She said "unattended" not "unintended", just for clarification Charlie.

Upon arriving at the festival, check in with Ray and Kristina at the information booth to get your member badge. He still needs a few more people to help with gates on Sunday, if you're able to help please contact him. Volunteer parking can be accessed through the vendor entrance at the first light on Blue Gum for volunteer parking.

We need as many people as possible to help with clean up on Sunday afternoon. We want to leave the campus looking better than when we arrived.
