Jim - auctioning off Richard R.'s putter at Deinstallation Dinner

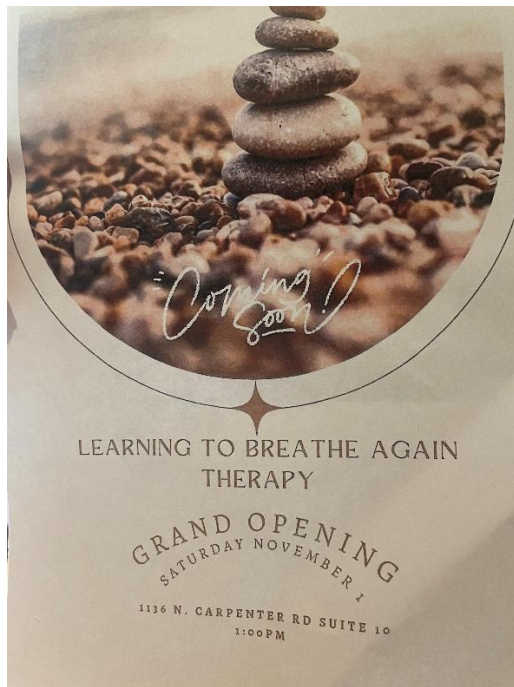
Ken - Peggy Ragsdale in hospital in San Diego; please keep her in thoughts and prayers
