Shower buses use water in and water out so need set locations with services. The homeless know the schedules and come to those sites. A Monday thru Thursday schedule. 8:30 to 12:30 with sign-ups taken. 6 min water timer. 15 min a shower. 10 showers an hour is possible.

Wait time can be used to build rapport.

Hiring a grant writer to access grants. Need money to run the program. If they got a big grant they would expand.

Stockton/Lodi and Sonora have similar operations now. Dean started with the San Francisco outfit providing similar services called 'Lave me'.

Partners with Jason at the mission.
