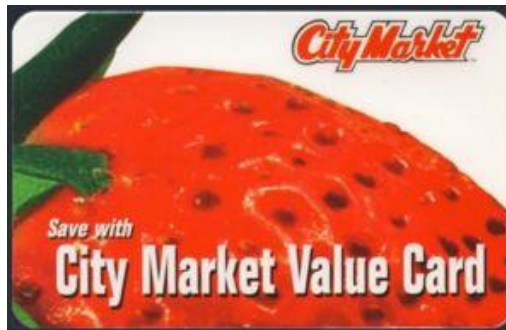

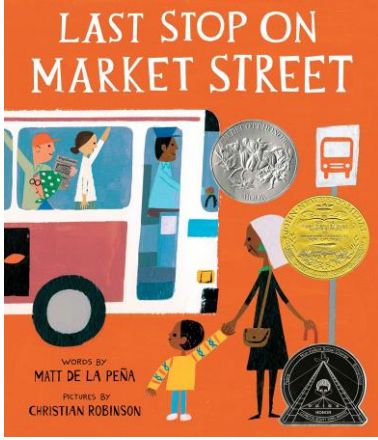

Join us this **Saturday, October 23rd at 9:00AM** to install a new story at the StoryWalk located at City Hall/Cole Park in Alamosa.

With the help of Kiwanis volunteers and Alamosa Children's Librarian Holly Van Hoy, we put together 32 poster boards that make up the new story- Last Stop on Market Street. This award-winning modern classic is an inclusive ode to kindness, empathy, gratitude, and finding joy in unexpected places, and celebrates the special bond between a curious young boy and his loving grandmother. Every Sunday after church, CJ and his grandma ride the bus across town. But today, CJ wonders why they don't own a car like his friend Colby. Why doesn't he have an iPod like the boys on the bus? How come they always have to get off in the dirty part of town?



Each question is met with an encouraging answer from grandma, who helps him see the beauty—and fun—in their routine and the world around them... Come see the story walk to learn where their bus finally stops.

This service project includes opening the metal frames, cleaning the plexiglass; spray painting the metal frames black where needed, installing the new poster boards, and then closing the frames.

Human & Spiritual Values: Implement projects that support spiritual development, provide human companionship and comfort. Provide support for members in need.

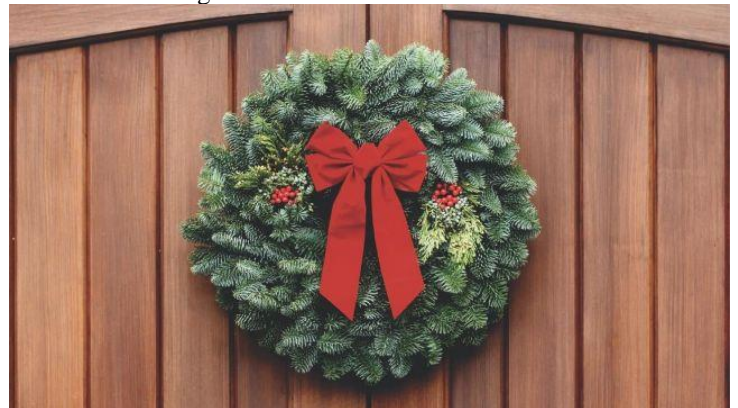
Membership Growth & Education: Strive to increase membership. Develop an effective new member orientation and induction ceremony. Promote regular attendance by all members.
