

Kiwanis Children's Fund volunteer positions

The Kiwanis Children's Fund is driven by volunteer leaders who serve in three different roles at the district and area levels.

AMBASSADORS

Ambassadors are appointed by the Kiwanis Children's Fund board for a three-year term. They act at the area level, providing critical connections between district chairs, district advocates, the Kiwanis Children's Fund Board of Trustees and Children's Fund staff. They are resources in fundraising and the training of volunteers.

DISTRICT CHAIRS

District chairs are appointed by the Children's Fund to work at the district level and are key to the continuing success of the Kiwanis Children's Fund. District chairs are fundraisers. They are passionate advocates of our mission and constant communicators of our five causes. They build and strengthen relationships with Kiwanians in their districts. District chairs represent the Kiwanis Children's Fund at district events and develop working partnerships with their district foundation, if one exists.

DISTRICT ADVOCATES

District advocates are appointed by the Children's Fund to work at the district level through the completion of The Eliminate Project. District advocates are fundraisers. They maintain the momentum and excitement of The Eliminate Project to its successful conclusion. District advocates also champion and inspire support of the Kiwanis Children's Fund.
