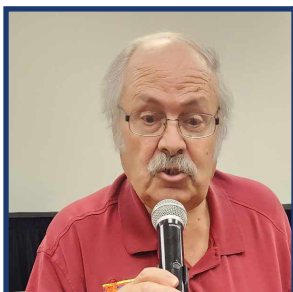


President Renee Brower

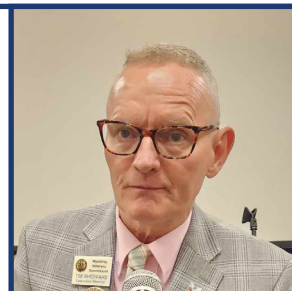

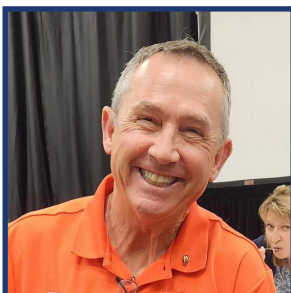
