## January 9, 2024 – Poudre Golden K Kiwanis Board of Directors Meeting

Call to Order – President Kevin O'Connell called the meeting to order at 10:15 AM; and there was a quorum of members.

**Approval of Minutes** – A motion was made by **Sam Kornfeld** to approve the minutes and seconded by **Stephen Andersen**. The motion passed.

**Secretary's Report –** Nothing to report other than sharing "housekeeping" information (finance) when reporting to Kiwanis International and Colorado Secretary of State at their respective websites.

**Treasurer's Report – Mark Tobin** passed out the Quicken quarterly "birdseye" (end of fiscal year/income-expenditure; and end of year) spreadsheets (Service and Administrative Accounts for October through December 2023). Motion to approve Treasurers' report was made by **Lloyd Wilson** and seconded by **Sam Kornfeld**, the motion passed.

Old Business – <u>PGK Finance Audit</u> is being completed (preliminary report) by **Henry Bauer** and **Don Edminster** for improving the reporting and documentation of financial information was discussed and implemented without the need for Board approval (all income goes into administrative account as opposed to Service account). Once the financial audit is completed and fully reviewed (reconciled) by **Sam Kornfeld**, the results will be shared. For future audits, all transactions (check number, amount, name, date, etc.) in chronological order would improve the efficiency of future reviews. The Board thanked Henry, Don, and Sam for all their work to date.

New Business – "Empty Bowls" charity activity is slated for February. What is the interest of the PGK to donate at the same funding level as last year (\$3,000 for two tables/priority seating)? An inquiry from O'Connell will seek those who plan to participate, and a similar methodology used for direct and indirect donations by PGK members. A motion by Stephen Andersen to purchase one (1) table (regardless of cost) from the administrative account be accepted by the Board. This motion was seconded by Lloyd Wilson and voted on by the Board. The motion carried.

A fund request from the Neighborhoods United Project (Ray Martinez) for \$2,000 was made. **O'Connell** suggested that \$1,000 be donated from the "Coins for Kids" activity and try and get a "match" for the other \$1,000 from the Rocky Mountain District Kiwanis.

Adjourn - A motion to adjourn by **Lloyd Wilson** and **Tom Trebon** seconded the motion. Motion to adjourn at 11:27 passed.


